Call to Order:

Motion was made by Quimby, 2nd by Zangs to approve amend General Penalty Provision Ordinance. Motion was carried 2-0. (Any person convicted of a violation of any section or provision of this Village Code, where no other penalty is set forth, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) for any offense. Each day any violation of any Section or provision of this Village Code continues shall constitute a separate offense)

New Business:

Motion was made by Quimby, 2nd by Zangs to approve amendment to curfew ordinance for minors-under the age of 17. Motion was carried 2-0. (curfew: Friday & Saturday 11:00 pm / Sunday thru Thursday 10:00 pm)

Motion was made by Quimby, 2nd by Zangs to approve amended building regulations for fences. Motion was carried 2-0. (**Height regulations.** No fence shall be constructed or erected in any residential, commercial or industrial district to a height exceeding six (6) feet, except where otherwise specified in this Code / Note attached ordinance)

Motion was made by Zangs, 2nd by Quimby to approve Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance. Motion was carried 2-0. (note attached ordinance)

It was recommended to approve Resolution to participate in the National Flood Plan Insurance program. (note resolution)
